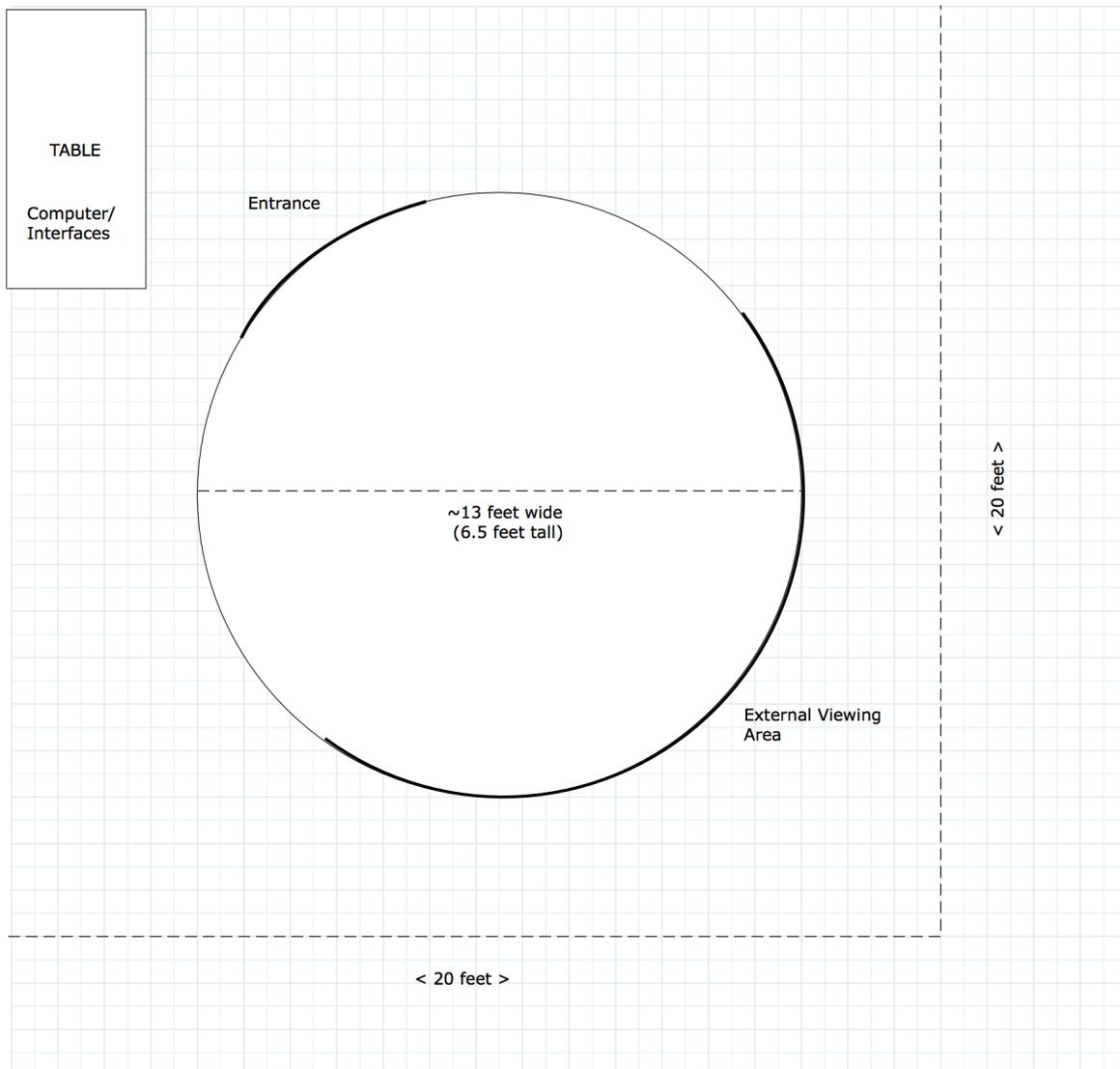

Facility/Space



LUCID requires 2 power outlets near the installation setup, a table for the computer and interfaces, a dark or very dimly lit space and preferably a space that allows for viewing area surrounding the exterior dome shell (for the external audience experience).

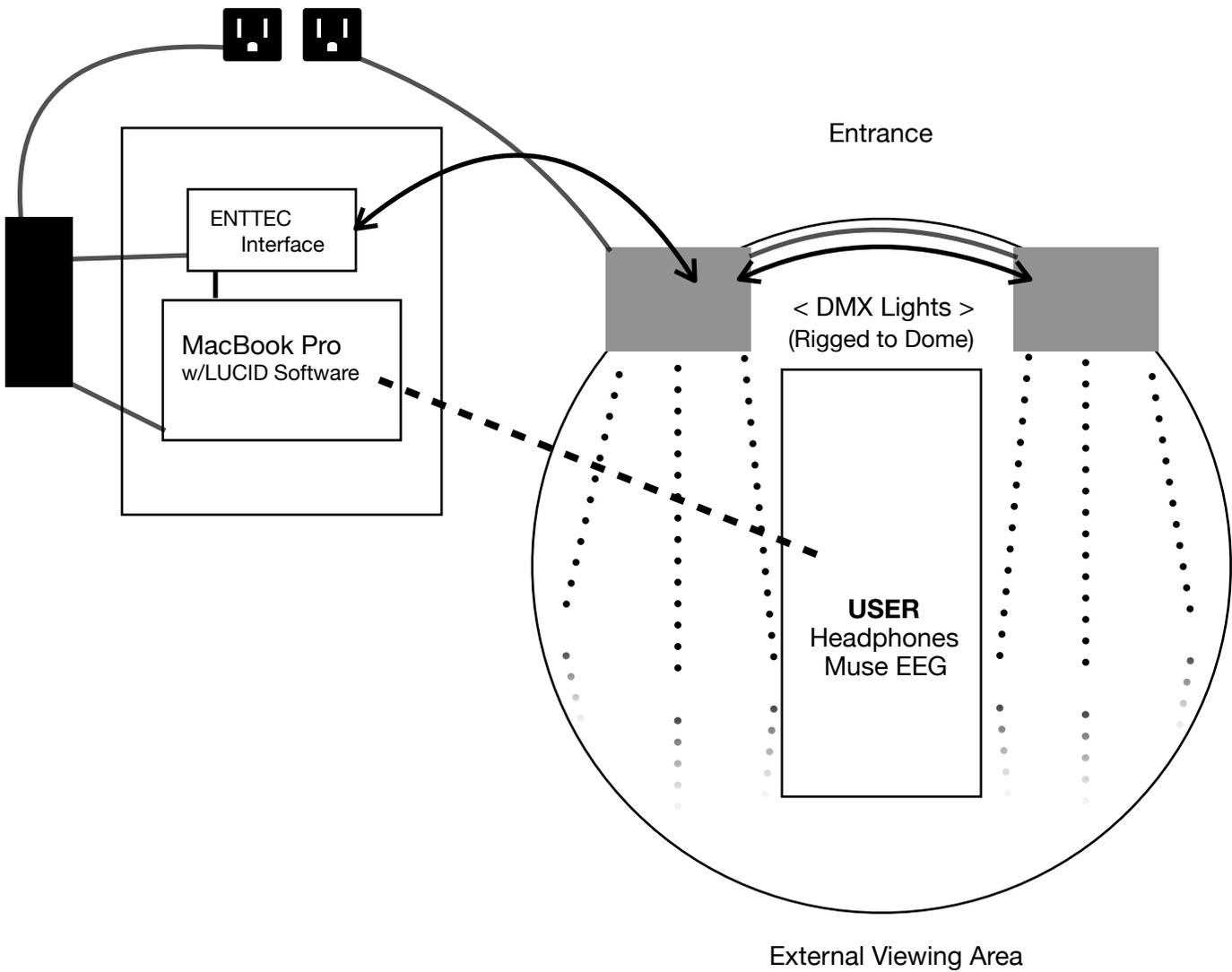

Operation Technicians

In order to function properly, LUCID requires a minimum of 1 (preferably 2) technicians to operate the piece at all times. This team is either hired by the Artist (depending on the budget and the nature of the event) or is provided by the gallery/event. If the gallery/event opts to utilizing their own staff to operate the piece, on-site training sessions can be arranged prior to the exhibition in order to teach the team how to run the installation properly and a detailed user manual is available upon request. Overall, the LUCID system is very user friendly to operate and most people can learn the interface quickly.
